

BRING YOUR OWN PILLOWS! We mentioned this a few times already, but we are not comfortable passing pillows from person to person. Everything else we have can be sanitized and laundered, but please bring your own pillows!

Let's talk about toilet paper. We know everyone prefers the plush fluffy toilet paper BUT no RV can accommodate that. RV toilet paper is thin and made that way on purpose. We do not want any toilet clogging so please use the toilet paper we provide for your trip.

Showers are very convenient to have - BUT if you are at a campsite that has restrooms and showers please considers using those. The showers in an RV need to be short, quick and to the point. They are not made for relaxation or teenagers (we know because we have them). The campsite will also have hotter water and better pressure that will last MUCH longer than in the RV.

Toilets are very convenient to have - BUT for easier cleanup after your trip you may want to enforce a #2 rule. If it's #1 no problem! If it's #2, go to the campground restroom that has full plumbing and real toilet paper (insert poop emoji here)

Based on the insurance policy and the State of Texas requirements, we require a \$1500 deposit the day of your booking. It will be released 2 days after your return and the RV is assessed for damage, missing items, or mileage charges.

Each reservation is allowed up to 200 miles per night. If you go over 200 miles per night there is a \$0.40/mile charge that will come out of your deposit.

All instruction will be provided to you via YouTube videos AND there will be a step by step instruction manual in the RV.

At the time of pickup we will walk through all "How-To's" in person - do a little test drive around the block so you are comfortable driving it - and give you all the details you need for a successful trip. Its way easier than you think!
